

## “Little Pumpkins” Sock



Yarn: SHEEPAINTS Bamboolaine 100 g /420 m  
Needles: 5 DPN 1,5 and 2

The pattern is made for size 6 with 64 stitches.  
For other sizes, just add or skip some of the knit stitches between the pattern repeats  
and add or skip pattern repeats for longer or shorter socks.  
The needles I used have half a size more as the ones I usually use with this yarn  
as the pattern is a bit less flexible.

Cast on 64 stitches (16 stitches on each needle) with size 1,5 needles  
and knit **chart 1** 4 times  
The charts show the pattern for needle 1 and 2, for needle 3 and 4 just repeat from the beginning.

### Leg :

switch to size 2 needles and repeat **chart 2** 4 times  
In the next row knit needle 1 and 2 **chart “End”**  
on needle 3 and 4 start again with the first row of chart 2

## Heel:



Continue only on needles 1 and 2 (best to put all 32 stitches on one needle) and purl 32 stitches (right side)  
turn knitting around  
(Wrong side) knit 3, purl 2, knit 2 until last 3 stitches, knit 3  
turn knitting  
knit 3, knit in the ribbing pattern till last 3 stitches, knit 3  
turn knitting  
continue the pattern until 24 rows are completed.

Row 25 (RS): knit 18 stitches, slip one stitch, knit one, pass slip stitch over the knitted one  
knit one  
turn knitting  
(WS) slip the first stitch with yarn in back  
purl 5, purl 2 together, purl 1  
turn knitting  
(RS) \*slip 1 stitch knit until 1 stitch before the gap, slip next stitch  
knit 1 stitch after the gap pass slip stitch over, knit one  
turn knitting  
slip first stitch purl until 1 stitch before the gap  
purl last stitch before the gap and first after the gap together, purl one  
turn knitting and repeat from \* until all stitches are on one needle again.

Next row (RS). Knit 9 stitches,  
with **free needle** knit the next 9 stitches and pick up 15 stitches at the border (24 stitches on needle 1)  
continue knitting needle 2 and 3 with chart 2

with free needle, pick up 15 stitches at the border of the heelflap and knit the next 9 stitches  
(24 stitches on needle 4)

Continue knittin in the round, decreasing 2 stitches in in every **2. row** as follows:

Needle 1: knit until last 3 stitches, knit two together, knit one

Needle 4: knit one slip one knit one, pass slip stitch over

Continue until there are 16 stitches on all 4 needles again

Continue knitting needles 1 and 4 and knit needles 2 and 3 according to chart 2

repat until chart is knitted 4 times

Next row: knit chart "End" instead of chart 2

### **Toe:**

continue only in knit stitch, decreasing every 2 rows as follows:

Needle 1 and 3: knit until last 3 stitches, knit two together, knit one

Needle 2 and 4: knit one, slip one knit one, pass slip stitch over

continue until there are 12 stitches on each needle

now decrease same way as before, but **EVERY** row

Continue until there are only 2 stitches on each needle.

Cut yam and slip it through the stitches

**Start immediately with second sock ;D**
